H. G. Fairfield Arts Center for the Environment is presenting the Nimham Mountain Music Festival at Putnam County Veterans Memorial Park on Saturday, May 11th from 2-10pm. The Festival will feature New Orleans Jazz Festival musician Martha Redbone Roots Project Band, rock'n'rollers Iron Cobra, & world blues/folk trio Bethany Yarrow, Rufus Cappadocia, with Brahim Fribgane, and the Nimham Mountain Singers, along with a BBQ, pony rides, vendors, and more.

Net proceeds from this event will benefit two projects: The first is the 13th Annual Chief Daniel Nimham Intertribal PowWow, a veteran's memorial powwow happening August 17-18, also at the Putnam County Veterans Memorial Park. The second project is an H. G. Fairfield Arts Media Workshop documentary film with the USMVMC NY 4 which aims to save lives. The documentary dovetails with our "Courage Continues At Home III" campaign with national comedian & Navy veteran PJ Walsh, as we follow PJ Walsh & the USMVMC NY4 trek from Wurtsboro, NY to San Antonio, TX for the National Meeting of USMVMC Presidents. PJ Walsh will perform for the veterans in San Antonio and H. G. Fairfield Arts will be the only outside vendor bringing in information about ways for families to cope with PTSD and other effects of war.
